

Layette Kits

- ◇ 6 cloth diapers
- ◇ 2 shirts or 2 one-piece body suits
- ◇ 2 baby washcloths
- ◇ 2 gowns or sleepers
- ◇ 2 diaper pins
- ◇ 1 sweater open in the front
- ◇ 2 receiving blankets

Important Kit Assembly Information

All items included in kits must be NEW items.

Bundle the items inside one of the receiving blankets and secure with the diaper pins.

All emergency kits are carefully planned to make them usable in the greatest number of situations. Since strict rules often govern product entry into international countries, it is important that kits contain only the requested items-nothing more.

Do NOT include any personal notes, money or additional materials in the kits. These things must be removed and will delay the shipment.

School Kits

Returning to a normal routine is the first step to recovery for children who have lived through natural disasters. School kits provide children with essential supplies to replace those damaged or destroyed.

- ◇ 1 Pair blunt scissors (rounded tip)
- ◇ 2 Pads or loose leaf (8.5 x 11" ruled paper)
- ◇ 1 30 centimeter ruler
- ◇ 1 Hand-held pencil sharpener
- ◇ 6 Unsharpened pencils with erasers
- ◇ 1 Eraser, 2.5"
- ◇ 12 Sheets of construction paper (varied colors)
- ◇ 1 box of 24 crayons

Prepare a 14" x 16" cloth bag with handles. A closer (Velcro, snap or button) is optional. Place all items in the bag. Patterns for the bag are available online at:

Sewing Kits

- ◇ 3 yards of cotton or cotton-blend, solid color or print fabric (must be 3 yards of uncut fabric)
- ◇ 1 pair sewing scissors
- ◇ 1 package of needles
- ◇ 1 spool of thread
- ◇ 5-8 matching buttons

Important Kit Assembly Information

All items included in kits must be NEW items.

All emergency kits are carefully planned to make them usable in the greatest number of situations. Since strict rules often govern product entry into international countries, it is important that kits contain only the requested items-nothing more.

Do NOT include any personal notes, money or additional materials in the kits. These things must be painstakingly removed and will delay the shipment.

Wrap sewing notions in the fabric and place in a sealed one-gallon plastic bag.



Flood Bucket

These supplies enable people to begin the overwhelming job of cleaning up after a flood or hurricane. If the requested size item is not available, select the next smaller size. If an item is not available in any size, affix a masking tape label on the outside of the bucket saying, "This bucket contains no _____."

- ◇ 1 5-gal plastic bucket with resealable lid
- ◇ 64-82 oz bleach
- ◇ 5 scouring pads
- ◇ 1 scrub brush
- ◇ 50 clothes pins
- ◇ 1 pair work gloves
- ◇ 7 sponges
- ◇ 18 cleaning towels (reusable wipes)
- ◇ 5 dust masks
- ◇ 2 pair latex gloves
- ◇ 50 oz liquid laundry detergent
- ◇ 12-16 oz household cleaner
- ◇ 16-28oz disinfectant dish soap
- ◇ 50-100 ft clothes line
- ◇ Pkg 24 heavy-duty trash bags (remove roll from box)
- ◇ 6-14 oz can insect repellent spray
- ◇ 8-9 oz can air freshener (aerosol cans must have protective caps)

Place all items in the plastic bucket and seal lid. Please ensure that all cleansing agents are liquids and in plastic bottles.



Health Kits

These "Health Kits" provide basic necessities for people who were forced from their homes. When people gain the materials to maintain personal hygiene, their overall health improves.

- ◇ 1 Hand towel (15 x 25" to 17x27")
- ◇ 1 Washcloth
- ◇ 1 Comb (not pocket size)
- ◇ 1 Nail file or fingernail clippers (no emery board or toenail clippers)
- ◇ 1 Bar of soap (3 oz or larger)
- ◇ 1 Toothbrush (single brush in original wrapper)
- ◇ 1 Large tube of toothpaste (expiration date must be six months or longer)
- ◇ 6 Adhesive plastic strip sterile bandages

Place these items inside a sealed one-gallon plastic bag.
